

The Fabric Forge 2026: Megaport Terraform Provider Contest Terms and Conditions

Contest Promotion Period

Starts 9:00:00 AM on 13th February 2026 AEST and ends 11:59:59 PM on April 22 2026 AEST.

General Conditions.

Megaport may cancel, suspend, or modify the Promotion at any time without the need for notice, for any reason, including, without limitation, if fraud or technical issues impact integrity. Megaport may disqualify entries that do not comply with these Official Rules. Megaport will have no liability to any entrants or winners.

Eligibility.

Open to Megaport active customers who receive the invitation. Employees of Megaport and affiliates are not eligible.

Winners' individual names and their organization's/company name and logos will be published on the Megaport website to celebrate their achievements. Submission of an entry will be considered the winners' written consent for Megaport to display their names and their organization's name and logo on the website in connection with the Program.

How to Enter.

During the Promotion Period, entrants must complete and submit the application to [<miwa.fujii@megaport.com>](mailto:miwa.fujii@megaport.com). Automated or duplicate entries are void.

Intellectual Property.

Your Submission must: (a) be your (or your Team, or Organization's) original work product; (b) be solely owned by you, your Team, your Organization with no other person or entity having any right or interest in it; and (c) not violate the intellectual property rights or other rights including but not limited to copyright, trademark, patent, contract, and/or privacy rights, of any other person or entity. An Entrant may contract with a third party for technical assistance to create the Submission provided the Submission components are solely the Entrant's work product and the result of the Entrant's ideas and creativity, and the Entrant owns all rights to them. An Entrant may submit a Submission that includes the use of open source software or hardware, provided the Entrant complies with applicable open source licenses and, as part of the Submission, creates software that enhances and builds upon the features and functionality included in the underlying open source product. By entering the Contest, you represent, warrant, and agree that your Submission meets these requirements and will indemnify Megaport for any claims, harm, or damages caused by violation of these terms.

Team representation.

If a team or organization is entering the Contest, they must appoint and authorize one individual (the "Representative") to represent, act, and enter a Submission, on their behalf. The Representative must meet the eligibility requirements above. By entering a Submission to Megaport on behalf of a team or organization you represent and warrant that you are the Representative authorized to act on behalf of your team or organization.

Application submission items.

1. Applicant’s information including, name, email address which is used for Megaportal login, contactable mobile phone number, position title and Megaport account name.
2. Problem Statement & Challenges: Clearly articulate the specific issues your solution addresses. Free text up to 500 words.
3. A diagram (architecture) generated from your Terraform (TF) code (using tools like inframap, pluralith, etc).
4. Sanitized snippet of the most interesting resource block(s). Make sure you do not include any access credential or any sensitive information.

Application submission due date.

11:59:59 on April 22 1 2026 AEST

Submission Modifications.

Prior to the end of the contest promotion period, Megaport may deem your Submission ineligible or may permit you to modify part of your Submission for the purpose of adding, removing or replacing material that potentially infringes a third party mark or right, discloses personally identifiable information, or is otherwise inappropriate. The modified Submission must remain substantively the same as the original Submission, with only modifications to resolve the infringing or inappropriate material or to remove the improperly disclosed personally identifiable information. The modified Submission must be resent prior to the end of the contest promotion period.

How to define winners.

All submissions will be evaluated by the Megaport Terraform Provider Team based on these criteria:

Multi-Cloud Integration	Extent of multi-cloud usage (Number of CSPs).
Complexity	Number of interconnected elements (Ports, MVEs, MCRs, VXC’s, Cloud providers, etc) visible in the architecture diagram.
Creativity	How unusual or insightful the use case is (for example, automated disaster recovery failover via Megaport VXC).
Code Quality (Merges Efficiency/Reusability)	Syntax clarity, resource definition logic, and security (sanitization) of the provided snippet. Is the code reusable?
Impact & Realism (Merges Realism/Utility)	Does this solve a genuine, high-value customer problem or major Terraform user pain point?
Communication	Clarity of the Problem Statement, any architectural diagrams, and supporting documentation.

Winners announcement.

Megaport will notify the winners directly via email by the middle of May 2026. If needed, Megaport may extend this deadline at its sole discretion.

Offer.

Winners will receive Megaport service credits (promo codes) in the amounts set forth below, equivalent to \$1,000 USD in local currency. The final value will be determined by Megaport based on the exchange rate within our systems at the time of conversion. The provided promo code can be applied to an MCR (Megaport Cloud Router), an MVE (Megaport Virtual Edge), a Port, or a VXC (Virtual Cross Connect) service. The winners will also receive five (5) Megaport Terraform (TF) Provider T-shirts.
